Joseph KASPAR SATTLER, ONE OF THE GREAT GERMAN ART NOUVEAU ARTISTS CREATED THESE NICE INITIALS IN 1897 FOR THE FAMOUS ROYAL MONUMENTAL BOOK PROJECT “DIE NIBELUNGE” FOR THE REICHSDRUCKEREI BERLIN. ONLY 200 EXCLUSIVE SIGNED MASTERPIECES WERE PRINTED IN FOUR YEARS FROM 1900 TILL 1904. Joseph SATTLER WAS THE ART DIRECTOR, TYPOGRAPHER AND DESIGNER IN ONE PERSON. THE REICHSDRUCKEREI SHOWED SAMPLES OF THE UNFINISHED WORK IN 1900 AT THE WORLD EXHIBITION IN PARIS TO ADVERTISE THE HIGH CRAFTSMANSHIP OF THE GERMAN PRIVATE PRESSES.

Nur 200 nummerierte, exklusive Bücher wurden in den Jahren 1900-1904 davon hergestellt. Joseph K. Sattler war der künstlerische Leiter, Illustrator und Typograph für dieses Projekt.

Joseph Sattler wurde am 26. Juli 1867 in dem bayrischen Städtchen Schrobenhausen im Haus Nr. 184 geboren und starb am 12. Mai im Schwabinger Hospital in München.

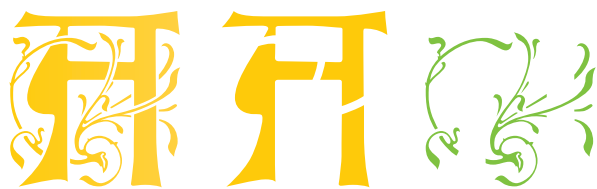
